

My Plan For Disney Solar System

This is the new plan and layout for an as yet unpurchased plot of land somewhere in the United States.

Notes about the land purchases size and location needs. It needs to be 400 square miles and be in a place with water and little to no snow.

Here is the map.

Lines on this map represent the monorails that will connect the different resorts.

The sun will consume 27.5 square miles.

Neptune will be 7.5 square miles

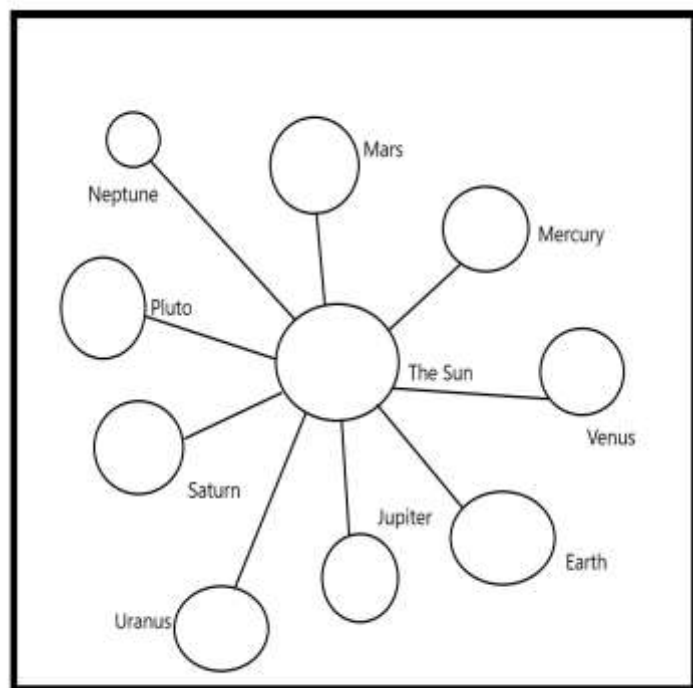


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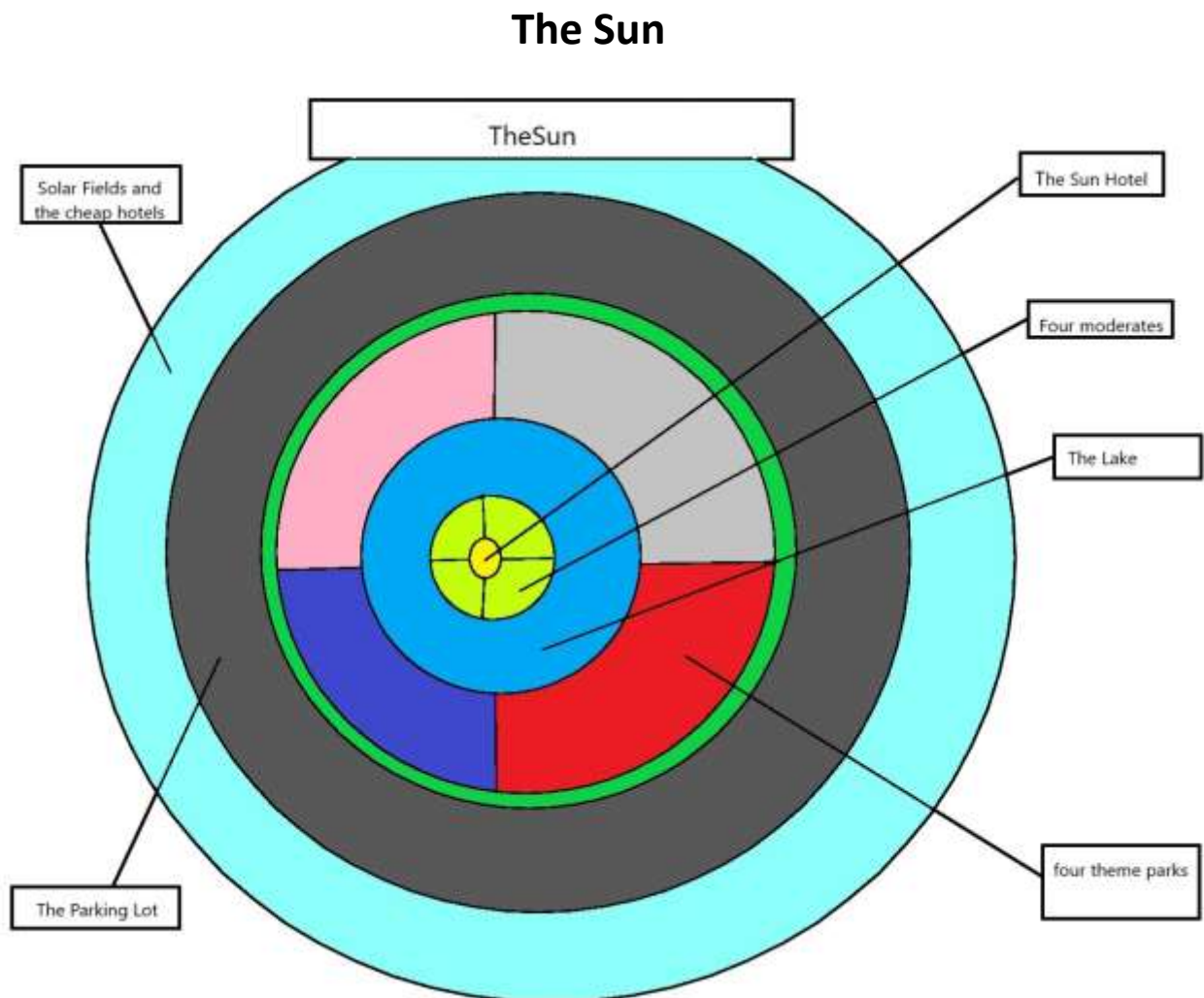
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Luxury Hotel – This hotel is the center of it all. The Description is below

The sun hotel- The sun hotel will be a beautiful golden palace and the only hotel with gondolas to each of the parks. They will have access to not only the amenities of the sun hotel but also they will have access to all the amenities of the moderate hotels including the boats for when the gondolas aren't working. The one issue for the whole Island is access to the parking area. I am thinking luxury subways direct to the lobbies of the hotels on the island.

Moderate Hotels- Walt's Dream was to mix fun with learning. Each of these 4 hotels will be built with the theme of a great empire from history so that children can learn about and from the past. They will provide boat access to the parks.

Persian Empire Hotel – imagineers choice

Han dynasty – imagineers choice

Inca Empire – imagineers choice

British empire – imagineers choice.

The Four Theme Parks –

Magic Kingdom – There will be a lot of repetition here but unique things to this magic kingdom should also be added. It should be the cheapest and easiest to design.

Epcot 2080 – The year comes from the year being imagined. This is the hardest park to create and will be generated with the standard practice of relying on the imagineers.

Charity Park – 20 charities will be picked and each will hold an auction with the proceeds going to that charity. The winner of the auction will be teamed with one imagineer and a member of the charity to design and build an attraction. All attractions will have to meet Disney Standards.

Youth Park – There will be a global art (Art can be poems, pictures, stories, basically anything to prove an imaginative person) contest for children. The submissions will be divided into six year olds, seven year olds, eight year olds and nine year olds. It will come with a fifty-dollar filing fee. Four winners will be chosen from each group. Each of these will be teamed with an imagineer to make attractions that will amuse parents as well as the young children.

A note about the inner sphere of the park up to the parking lot. Before building anything an underground system of buildings and tunnels must be built for

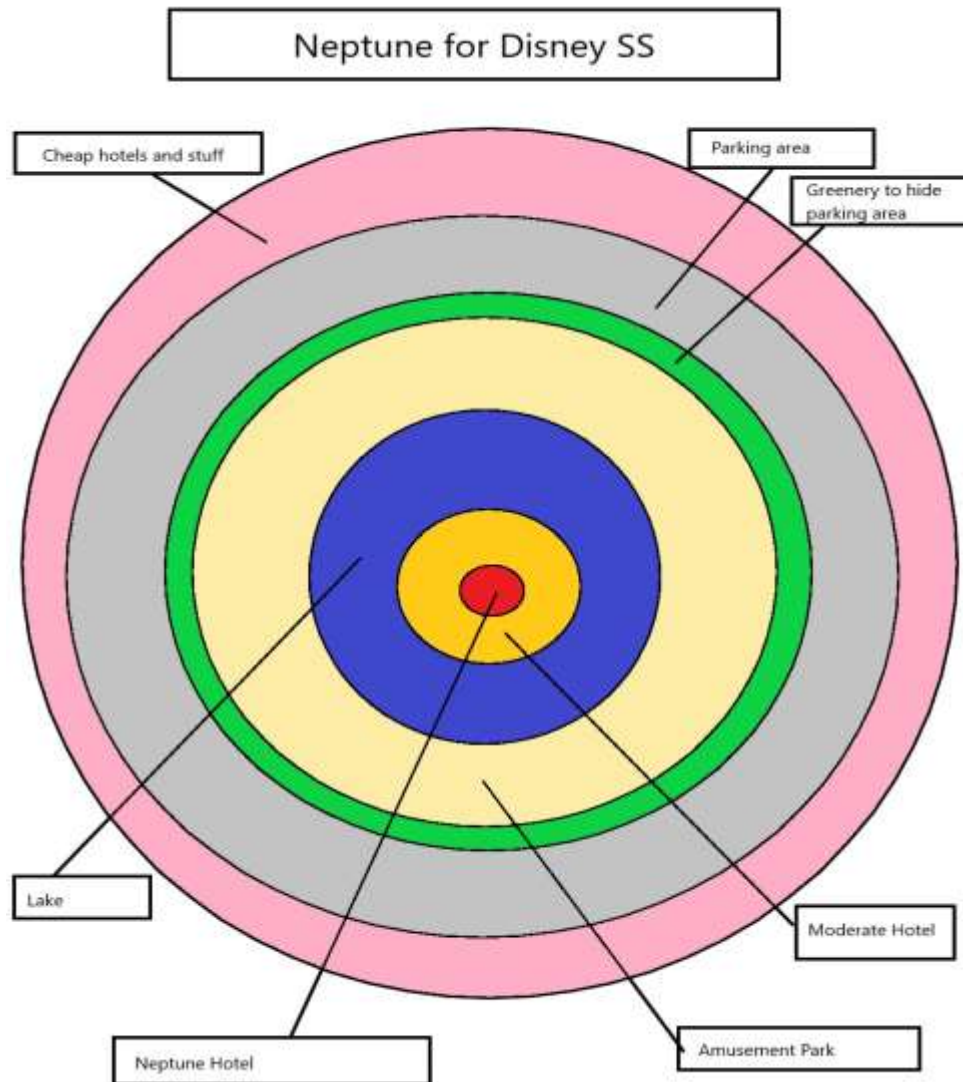
allowing vehicles (both maintenance and emergency) access to everywhere. Also between each amusement park will be backstage areas which are not show on the map.

The green line on the map denotes a wooded area because it wouldn't do to see the parking lot from any of the parks. The parking lots are self-explanatory.

The Outer Band – This band is kind of a mish-mash of things. The economy hotels which will be many. Solar Fields and Windmill fields for power. Golf Courses. Race car track. Anything to make a buck. The theme of the economy hotels have yet to be decided.

Neptune

Note about neptune: Its target market is 16 to 25.



Luxury Hotel – The neptune hotel is the center of it all. It will contain views of neptune and give the feeling of living on neptune if it had air. It will have gondolas to the park and the inner island will have a subway to and from the parking lot.

Moderate Hotel -This will be themed in extreme sports. It will provide boat access to the parks and all amenities will be available to the luxury hotel.

The Theme Park –The theme park will be thrill rides but there is no reason not to have repetition of rides from other planets. Tower of terror, tron, star wars roller coaster, expedition Everest and so on. The first park Disney makes that is almost a hundred percent thrill rides.

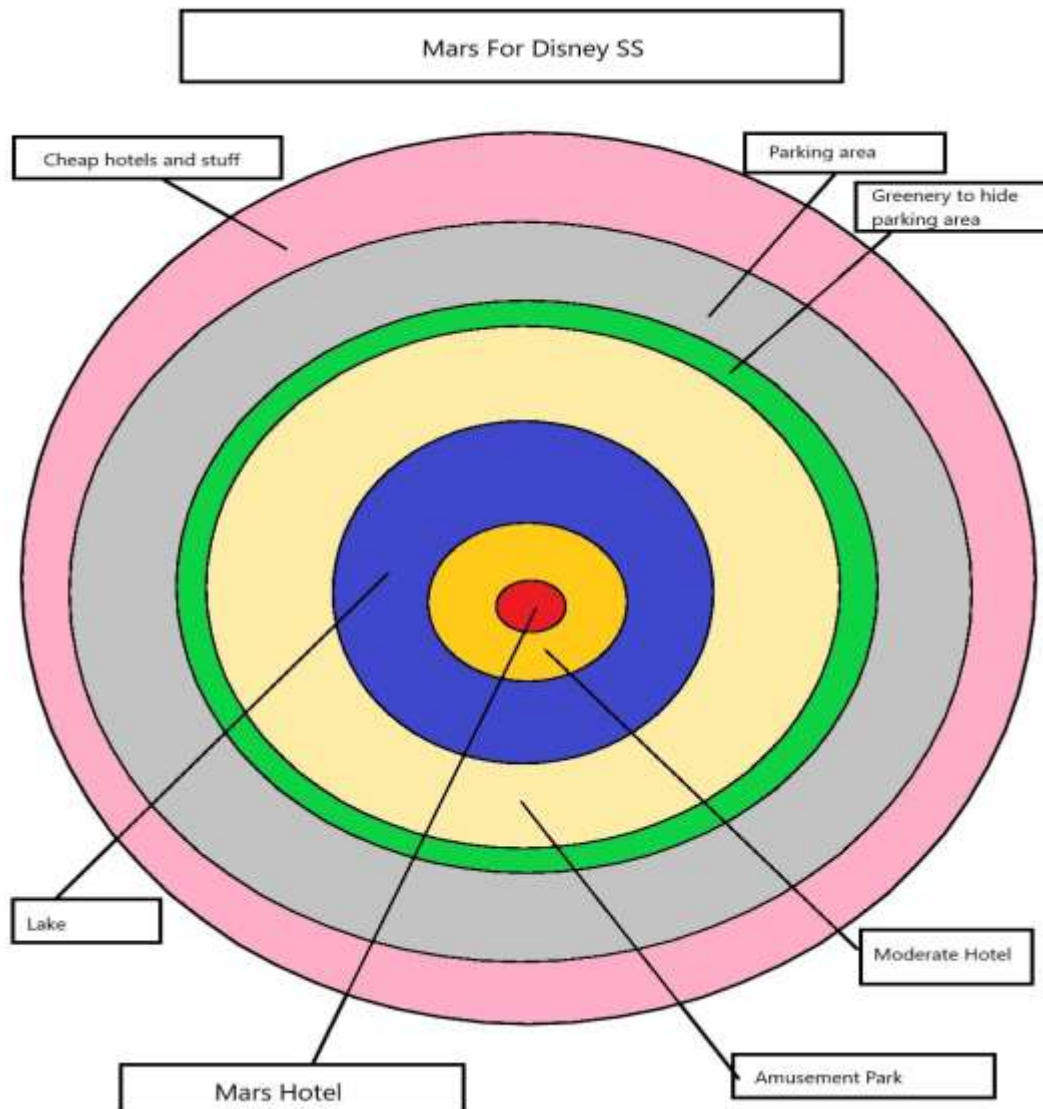
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The Outer Band – This will contain the necessary wind farms and solar fields plus skate parks shopping, economy hotels and anything Disney feels will make a buck.

Moderate Hotel-The theme for the moderate hotel is tough stuff and the working class. Buildings will be inspired by huge construction equipment (Earth Movers, Cranes, Bulldozers) and such. Next to the pool there will be an open area where once a day either a strongman competition or a logging competition will be held.

Theme Park-I can't speak to this. 20 Hero's selected from a lottery of hero's will be awarded the opportunity to collaborate with twenty imagineers on 20 attractions.

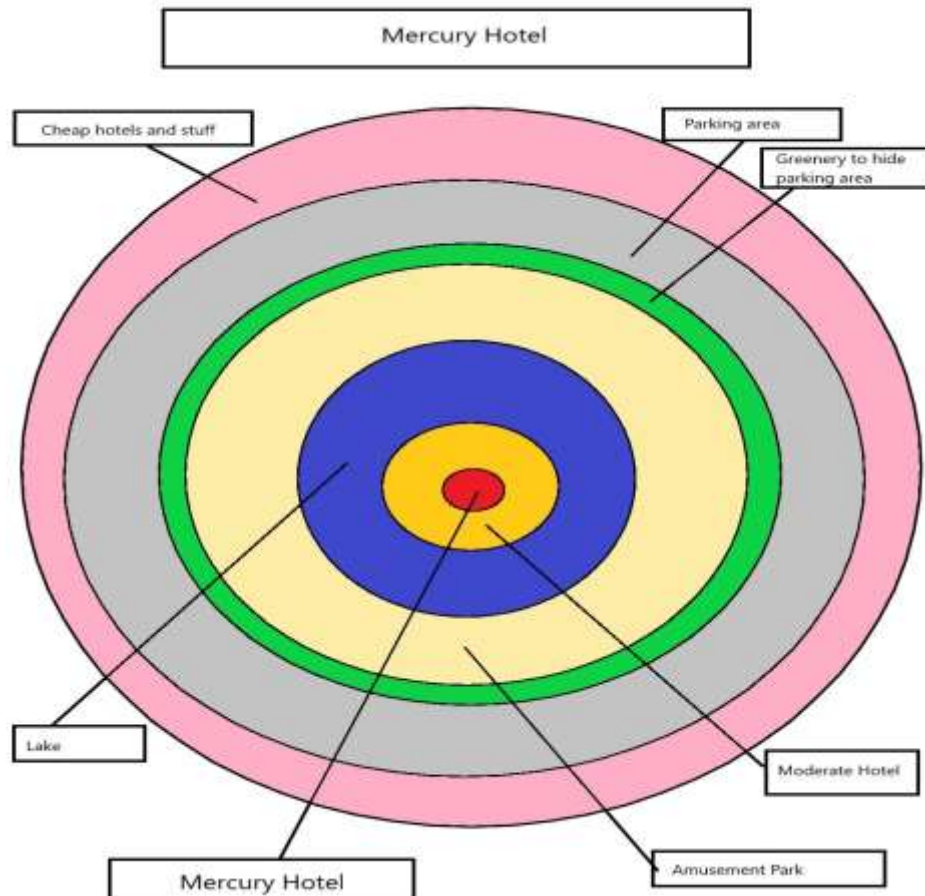

Moderate Hotel- It will provide boat access to the parks and all amenities will be available to the luxury hotel. Everything about this must be as advanced as possible and as clean as

Theme Park-Think of tomorrow land on steroids. Each ride will be accompanied by a technical representation of a new technology. Lots of rube Goldberg machines. Anything that sparks thinking is welcome.

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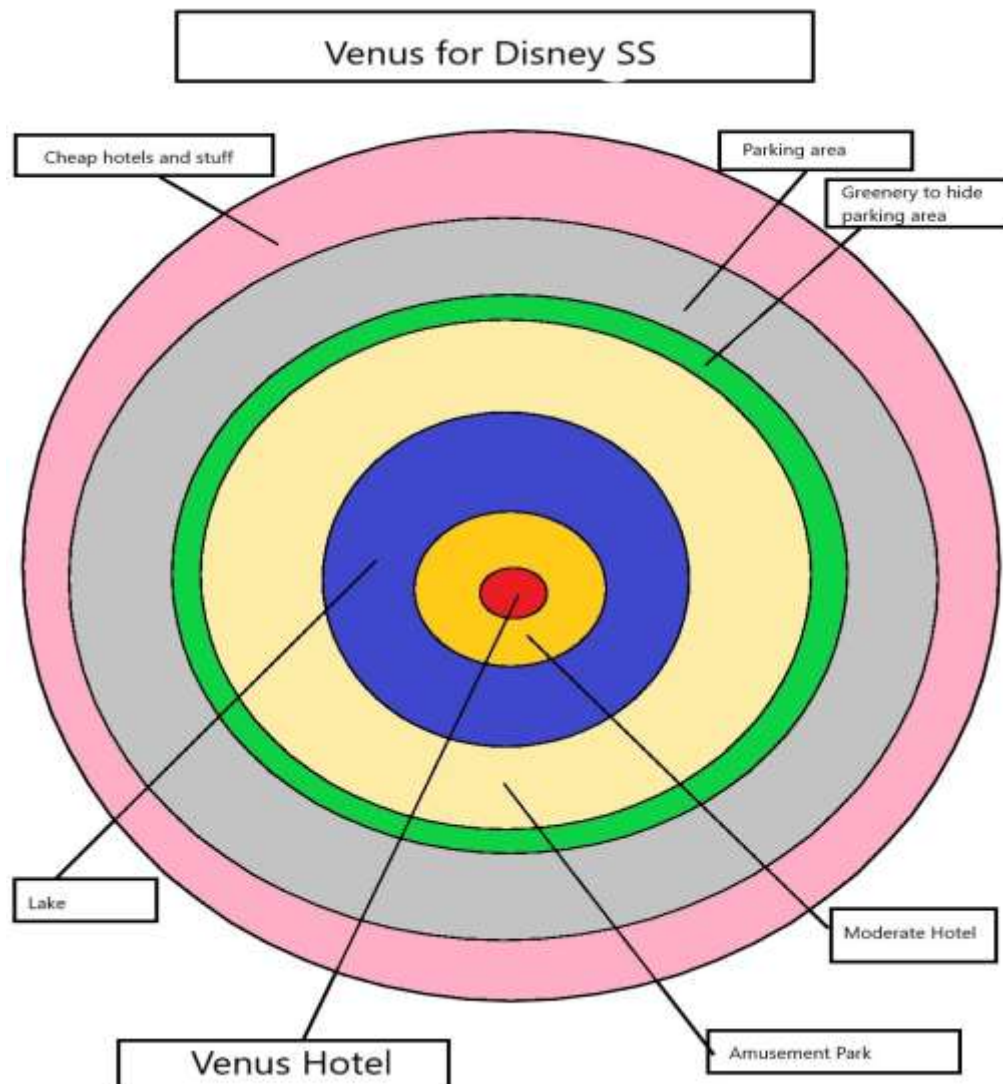

Luxury Hotel – It will have gondolas to the park and the inner island will have a subway to and from the parking lot. This

hotel will be all Roman decked out and filled with spas and whatever women love.

Moderate Hotel- It will provide boat access to the parks and all amenities will be available to the luxury hotel. This hotel will be all castle themes and it will be run by a Queen with her court following her around as she wanders the grounds all day.

A couple examples of her power:

A child's cake falls on the floor. She calls sir such and such and commands him to see to it that the cake is cleaned up and a new piece is provide to the child.

A child is crying so the queen orders her jester to make the child a balloon animal. You get the idea.

Theme Park-It will be princess to the gills and instead of a hall of presidents, there will be a hall of great women from history. Other then that, it is lady imagineers' choice.

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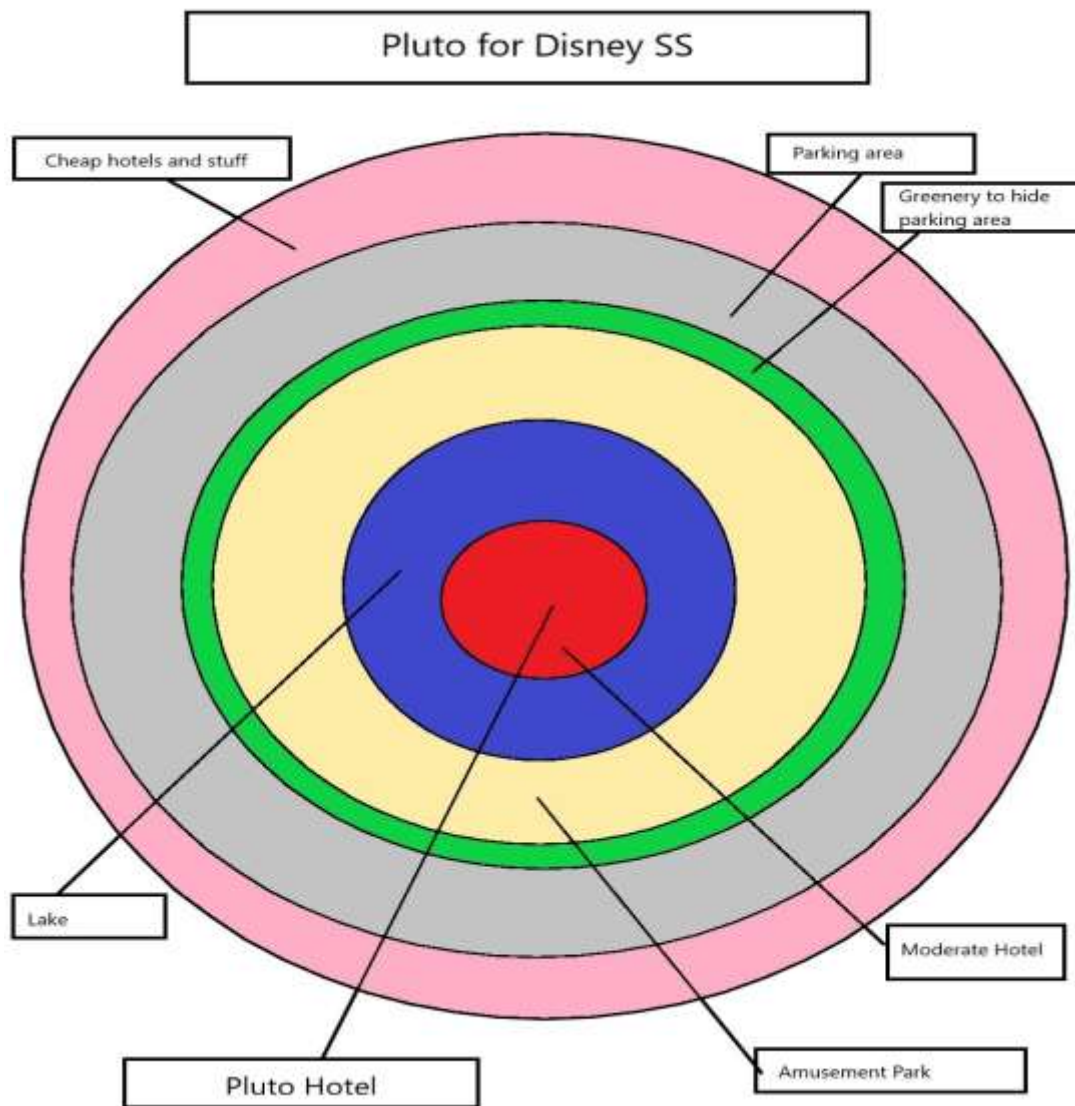

Planet: Pluto

Note about: Its target market is pet lovers.(this will be the smallest of planets and will require great engineering to happen)



Luxury Hotel – It will have gondolas to the park and it will provide boat access to the parks. It will be quite expensive because this will be the only planet where you can bring your pet. Due to the extra land needed for your pets, there will be

no moderate or economy hotels. It will have a subway to and from the parking lot. It will have pet sitting services for days when you want to engage in park activity. This service will make this one of the more costly planets as the guest to cast member ratio will have to be much lower than normal

Theme Park- Mostly it is up to the imagineers to make a park that pet owners like but I suggest shows about training pets, pet tricks, basic pet medical care, a wall of the ugliest pets and so on.

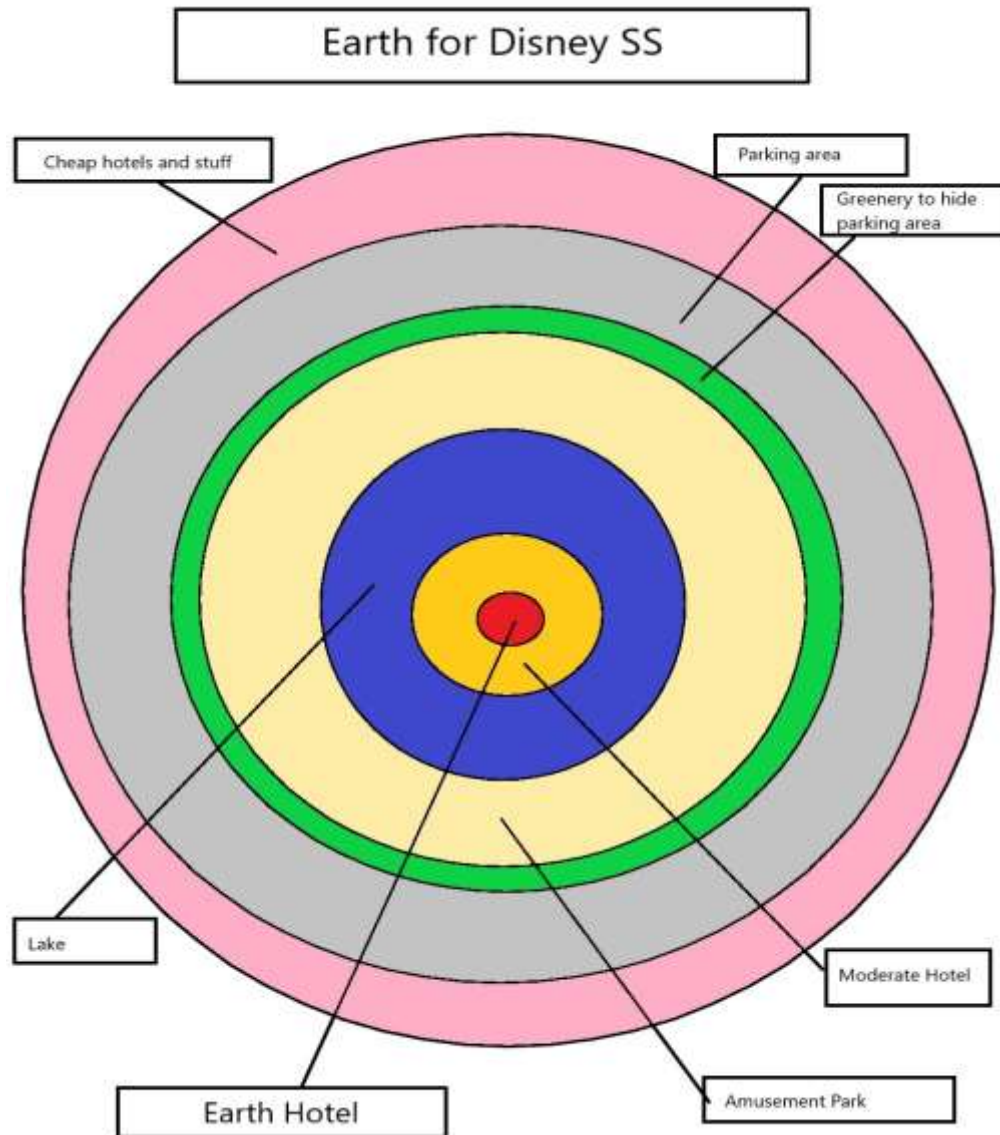
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The Outer Band – This band is kind of a mish-mash of things. The economy hotels which will be many. Solar Fields and Windmill fields for power. Anything Disney feels will make a buck. Like a store that consults with the pet's owner to make custom pet collars. An obedience school if you have an out-of-control pet. Planet: Earth

Note about: Its target market is senior citizens and handicapped.



Luxury Hotel – It will have gondolas to the park and the inner island will have a subway to and from the parking lot. This hotel is probably the easiest but it has to be spectacular. All hotel rooms must be handicapped friendly. Walk in showers. I

suggest it be broken down into seven sections representing each continent.

Moderate Hotel- It will provide boat access to the parks and all amenities will be available to the luxury hotel. Baseball, basketball and football games will be the theme. Basically this hotel is for sports lovers except for extreme sports. Those guys should go to planet Neptune) It may sound counterintuitive for sports to be for the handicapped but those guys are as good as anyone. I think it is judgmental to say they can't play and love sports.

Theme Park-The theme of the park should be nostalgia. Boardwalk with wide walk ways. Each section should come with a decade starting with the sixties and going to the 2000's. Rides that concentrate on easy access and many benches for resting. 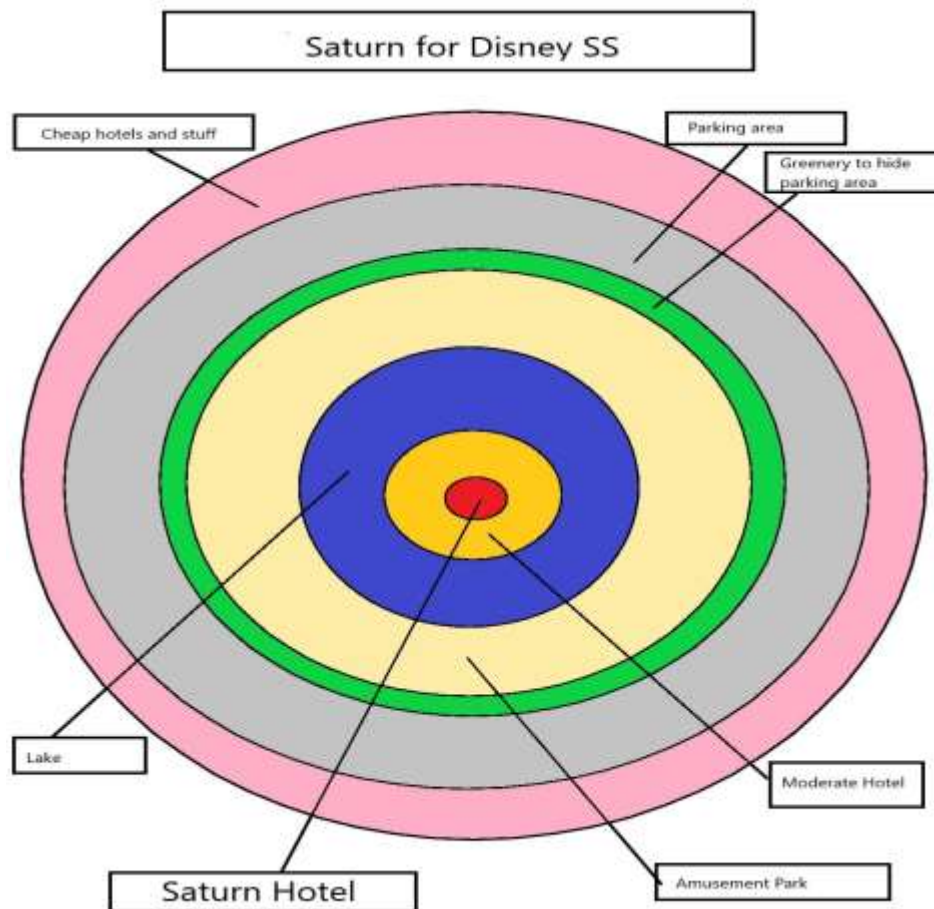

Moderate Hotel- It will provide boat access to the parks and all amenities will be available to the luxury hotel. Things done to

improve must be everywhere without being seen so that you can walk around reading signs explaining all the crafty things that can be done to increase environment. Sound, smell, touch, taste, sight should all go to create a peaceful environment without anyone noticing.

Theme Park-This has to be the most environmentally friendly park. Even if it makes it more expensive to operate, everything that can be done must be done to make it as harmless to the environment as possible. Attractions should showcase environments that are in danger as well as how wonderful these environments can be. Soaring is a good example of a current ride that does this.

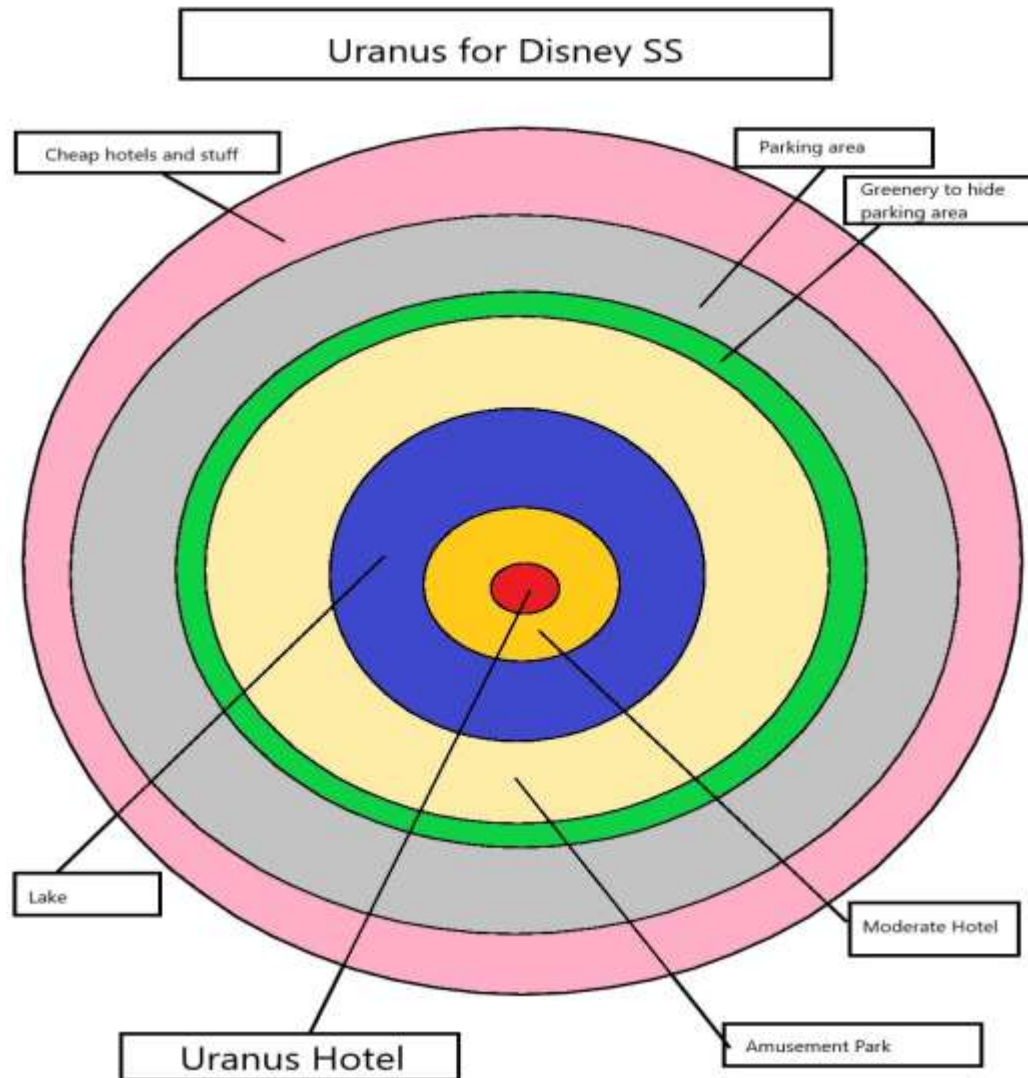
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Planet Uranus:

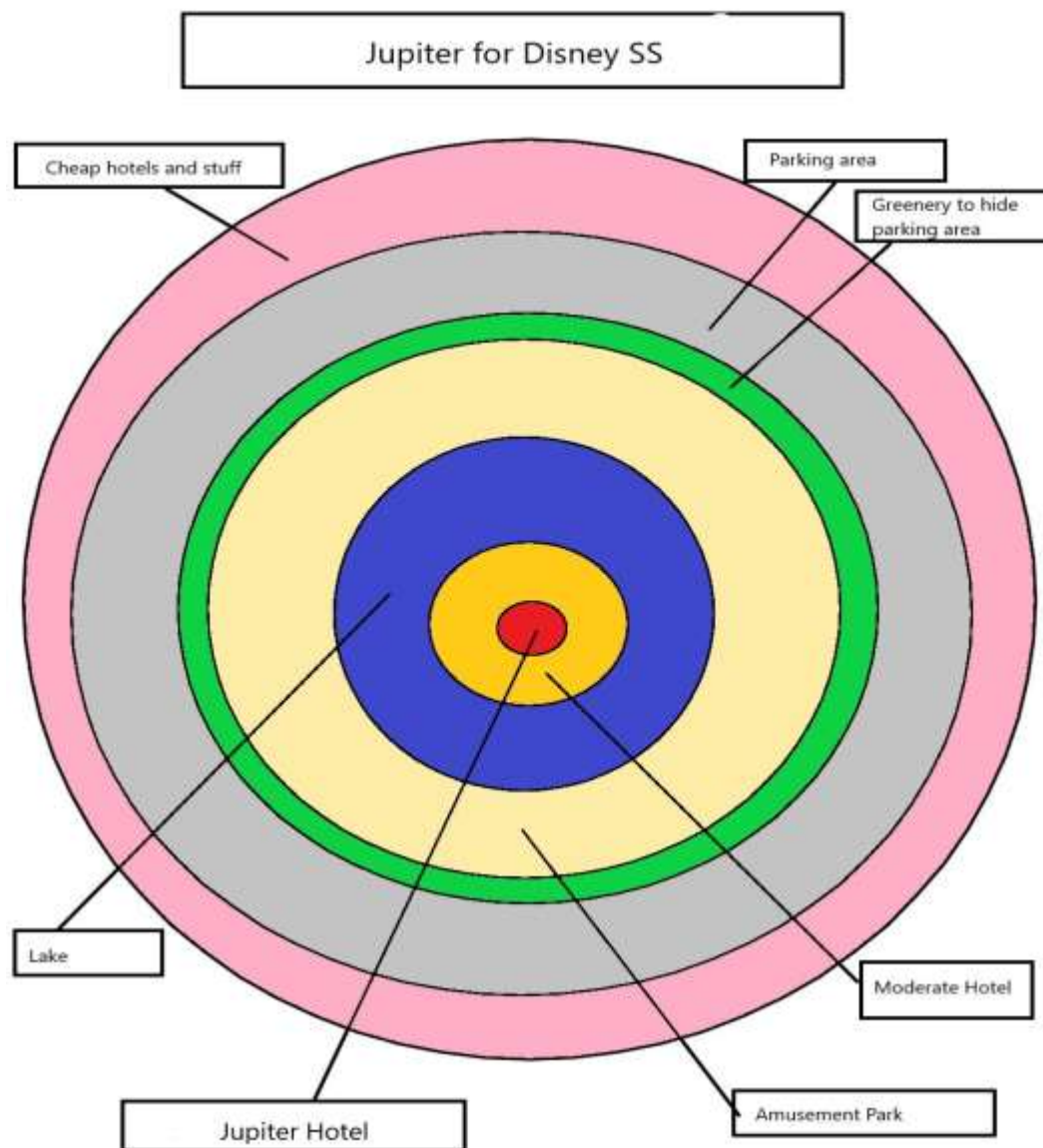
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Planet Jupiter:

Moderate Hotel- It will provide boat access to the parks and all amenities will be available to the luxury hotel. The theme for this will be the menu.
